

Toe or Knee the peg.

Toe the peg with your leading foot means:

Right handed archers uses left foot.

Left handed archer uses right foot.

Your toe is touching the back of the peg.

You also need to be behind the peg: archer, peg then target.

If you kneel you knee the peg and are behind the peg.

Shooting order.

Shoot all required pegs in order before the next archer shoots.

Score all arrows before any arrows are removed from the target. Challenge any scores that you do not think has been called correctly. (It's your right.)

Scoring (Line Cutters)

NFAS states that if an arrow touches the line, it is in. This line must be the wound or kill line. Most animals wound line is inside the animal outline.

Horns, hooves, beaks, rocks and branches to name but a few, do **NOT** count.

Etiquette to other archers.

Replace face pins when you have finished at the target.

Do not move the target or peg to where you want it; it's where it is for a reason.

Do not talk to the archer who is shooting, talk amongst you but do it quietly.

Pegs are supposed to be upright in the ground, if you knock it over, stand it up.
