Club Constitution

The following amendment is being made to the Club Constitution with regard to our new lease.

The club representative on the lease is the tenant and all fees related to tenancy shall be paid for by the club.

The death of the tenant makes the lease null and void.

The lease does not have to be renewed by Binsted Farms Ltd.

The rent is reviewed every 3rd year. The rent needs to be agreed 3 months before anniversary.

The lease needs to be sorted for renewal 6 months before expiry due to the landlords solicitor not meeting deadlines on time.
